Overclocking can be very dangerous and we are **not** responsible for dead devices.

Overclocking has a lot of **Pro's** and **Con's**:

Overclocking can increase stability in game performance, but this comes at a cost.. Your device will start cranking out more heat, and if you don't have a plan in place, it can fry the device. It's always encouraged to take measures against issues like this. Some examples would be, put your device in an open area that can draw airflow, use heatsinks, etc.

These overclock settings are not random, they're pretested settings that show real world improvements. They can be changed by going left or right on the Dpad.

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
