

# Texas Instruments TI-99/4A



Under construction.

The TI-99/4 is a home computer released in 1979. It retailed for \$525 USD, which is equivalent to \$1,490 after adjusting for inflation (in 2020)! Partially due to its exuberant price and lack of software support, it only sold around twenty-thousand units.

The TI-99/4A is an incremental upgrade to the original TI-99/4, at half the price of the original unit. Needless to say it was much more successful, it sold around three **million** units.



Does Batocera support emulating both models? Good question!

## BIOS

Requires MAME BIOS file ti99\_4a in ZIP or 7Z format in either the ti99/ or BIOS folder.

## ROMs

Cartridges need to be in \*.rpk format and unzipped. The MAME software list files (\*.bin) will not run properly.
